



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Partnership Programmes between

The University of Allahabad

and

Centre of Biomedical Magnetic Resonance

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is being made between the University of Allahabad, Allahabad - 211002, India, hereinafter referred to as 'AU'

and

Centre of Biomedical Magnetic Resonance, Lucknow, hereinafter referred to as 'CBMR'.

In order to promote cooperation and the advancement of academic, research, and educational exchanges between AU and CBMR the two institutions agree to formalize an MoU which is as follows:

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of cooperation will be pursued:

1. Use of facilities for Research

CBMR would allow scholars from AU, the use of functional imaging system and other systems for research purposes. AU in turn would in the selfsame manner allow scholars from CBMR to avail of its facilities for research purposes.

2. Academic visits/Exchange of faculty

The two institutions will collaborate in planning and delivery of academic programs and courses and will also partner with each other in organization of seminars, workshops, and conferences including the exchange of mutual experiences in teaching and research.



3. Joint teaching programs, research activities and publications

The two institutions will collaborate in developing teaching programmes in interdisciplinary areas of specialization of high relevance to both the institutions at the post-graduate and doctoral levels. AU and CBMR will explore the modalities for providing degrees or certification for students coming out of these programmes. The two institutions will also take up joint research projects.


4. Participation in seminars and academic meetings


The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) shall remain in force for a period of **five years** from the date it is signed by the appropriate officials of the two institutions. It may be extended further or amended with the written agreement of both the parties. This MoU may be terminated by either party subject to the delivery of one year's advance notice, in writing.

Both the parties agree that an Academic-Cum-Administrative Committee consisting of their nominees will be constituted to work out the operative details for the successful implementation of this MoU.
