

The Chairman extended a warm welcome to all members of Academic Council, Special Invitees and the newly appointed Heads of Department. Thereafter, the agenda item were taken-up.

- Agenda No. 01/37 To consider the letter No.F.No.32-1/2012-Desk (U), Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi dated 16-07-2019 of Sri Umesh Kumar, Under Secretary to Government of India regarding matter of Institute of Correspondence Course & Continuing Education, (ICC&CE).
- **Resolution No.01/37** The Registrar informed the Hon'ble Members that the Academic Council in its meeting held on 08-06-2018 had recommended vide Resolution No.01/31 to the Executive Council to suspend the academic activities at ICC & CE till the Hon'ble Visitor's decision in the matter was received. The recommendation of the Academic Council was approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 17-06-2018 vide Resolution No.03/49. Accordingly a letter was sent by the University to the Under Secretary, MHRD, New Delhi conveying the decision of the Executive Council to suspend the academic activity till the Hon'ble Visitor's decision in the pending matter of amendment in the Statutes for declaring the ICC&CE an integral part of the University was received.

Executive Council vide Resolution No. 06/54 decided to go for closure of ICC&CE since it was not financially viable to run the Institute.

The aforesaid Resolution along with the Comprehensive Report was sent to MHRD vide Registrar's letter no.05/R/281/2019 dated 24-03-2019.

In this connection a letter No.32-10/2010/2012-Desk (U) dated 16th July, 2019 was received from the Under Secretary, MHRD whereby the MHRD had asked the University to repeal the existing provision of the Statutes 30(2) if it intended to close the temporary Self financing ICC&CE on permanent basis.

The above letter of MHRD dated 16th July, 2019 was placed before the Academic Council. The Academic Council unanimously resolved to close the ICC & CE permanently and recommended for the repeal of the provision mentioned in the University's Statutes 30 (2) i.e.

"The Institute of Correspondence Courses and Continuing Education shall continue as a temporary self- financing University Institute, and all matters relating thereto shall be provided for by the Ordinances"

It was further resolved that as a sequel thereto the Ordinance No. XXXII -

The Institute of Correspondence Course and Continuing Education – and all Regulations relating to the ICC&CE would also stand repealed with immediate effect.

The Academic Council further resolved to recommended to the Executive Council the above Resolution for its consideration and approval. All the documents mentioned in the Resolution are appended here on **Appendix-A**


