## ANC801: RESEARCH METHODOLOGY (4 CREDITS)

- 1. Meaning, Types of researches, and their significances.
- 2. Methods of Historical and Archaeological inquiry subjectivity, objectivity, authenticity of sources.
- 3. Definition of facts, theory, concept and hypothesis and their interrelation.
- 4. Hypothesis: formation, plagiarism and Ethics.
- 5. Research methods, techniques and their role in the identification and handling of sources with special reference to Script and Language.
- 6. Project writing and the basic components of the project.
- 7. Analytical study process, basic elements and relevance in research.
- 8. Communication and Computer Application skills.

## ANC802: AREA SPECIFIC HISTORIOGRAPHY AND SPECIAL METHODS (4 CREDITS)

- 1. Advanced knowledge in the historiography and sources relevant to subject areas: Archeology, Art and Architecture, Socio-economic history, Religion and Philosophy.
