
NOTIFICATION

As per the directions received from University Grants Commission vide D.O. No.F.6-1/2018(SCT) dated 5th December, 2019, passed in the W.P.(C) No.292/06 titled " Disabled Rights Group & Anr.Vs. UoA & Ors" accordingly, as per the directions of the competent authority, UoA is committed to compliance with the provision of Section 32 of the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016 while dealing with the issue of reservation of seats in admission of students in each course and notifying the compliance each year to UGC. As per the provision of the Section 32 of the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016, which is re-produced as under: "Reservation in higher educational institutions"

- (1) All Government Institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five per cent. seats for persons with benchmark disabilities.
- (2) The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education.

Further, all the Principals are requested to open 'Equal Opportunity Cell' in their respective colleges as well as followed other directions as received from the UGC in the above mentioned letter and an action taken report need to submit in this regard to the office of the undersigned.

This is for strict compliance.

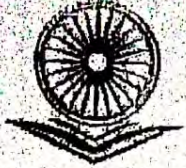

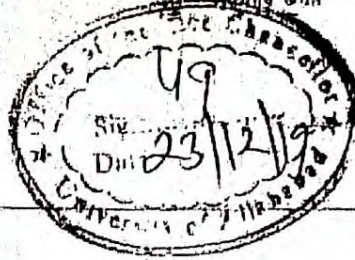

Sub: Action taken Report on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 15 December, 2017 passed in the W.P. (C) No. 292/06 titled "Disabled Rights Group & Anr. Vs. UOI & Ors"

Dear Sir/ Madam,

Your kind attention is invited to our letter of even number dated 11.01.2019 and its subsequent reminders dated 11.06.2019 and 06.11.2019 on the above mentioned subject. You were required to implement the following recommendations in your university/constituent and affiliated colleges in compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court orders dated 15.12.2017 in WPC No. 292 of 2006:

- Compliance with the provision of Section 32 of the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016 while dealing with the issue of reservation of seats in admission of students in each course and notifying the compliance each year to UGC.
- Adoption and Implementation of Harmonised Guidelines and Space Standards for Barrier Free Built Environment for Persons with Disability and Elderly Persons, developed in February, 2016 by Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India, to make the existing buildings barrier free and accessible for Persons with Disabilities and also at the time of approval of the plan and Detailed Project Report in cases of new buildings.
- Formation of an Internal Committee comprising teachers, staff, students and parents for taking care of day to day needs of differently-abled persons as well as for implementation of the schemes.
- Ensuring the proper functioning of Equal Opportunity Cell in the Colleges, Universities and other higher education institutions.

As Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 25.10.2019 has directed UGC to file a detail report on the compliance of its order dated 15.12.2017, you are once again requested to furnish the compliance report to UGC latest by 12 December, 2019 in the prescribed format at sctsection@gmail.com / chaubh.ugc@nic.in.
