To consider the matter of rising indiscipline, among the University students.

Resolution No.01/39 It was resolved that discipline rules like other Central Universities be accepted for implementation in the University of Allahabad. The draft rules were circulated to the members who gave their consent for adoption for the University. These rules may also be placed on the University website and also for circulation among Students.

The Vice-Chancellor informed that he has visited, the Centre of Globalization & Development Studies, A.U. for inspection. During the visit it was found that there are serious complaints against the Coordinator, Prof. V.P. Singh. Some of the complaints that were made to the Vice Chancellor are as under:-

- That Prof. V.P. Singh has not been taking any classes, the books that have been purchased in the Centre have not been issued or used by the users (students and faculty) and Computer were purchased but they have never been put to use by the Coordinator of the Centre for Students. These were found locked in the HOD's room at the time of inspection.
  - The Vice-Chancellor has removed, with immediate effect, Prof. V.P. Singh, from the Coordinator ship of the Centre, pending an enquiry and an Office Order No. 05/R/312/2016 dated 30-04-2016, regarding irregularities in the Centre has been issued, and is reported for record. The final action against Prof VP Singh shall be taken only after receiving the enquiry report.
- 2. A Notification no. 05/R/323/2016 dated 03-05-2016 is reported regarding suspension of Dr. Santosh Kumar, Assistant Professor, and Centre of Globalization & Development Studies. A.U. till further orders, who has not been coming to the Department for the past five months. The same has not been informed in time by the Coordinator, to the Offices of the University, for stopping of Salary and other action on his absence. An Enquiry Committee has been constituted to look in to the matter of absence of Dr. Santosh Kumar, vide notification 05/R/323/2016 dated 03/05/2016.
- A JRF, SC Student, Shri Vikas Saroj, had applied for admission to Ph.D. Course in the Center, was denied admission, and in his place a student from general category has been given admission. This matter is also being looked into.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
