A wait list shall be drawn, from where the candidate can be recruited in case the incumbent joins and leaves, in the case of death and retirement. The wait list shall be valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of Executive council meeting i.e. 07.03.2025.

The members of the Executive Council gave a thumping applause to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor for recruiting 137 non-teachings (MTS) staff members to ensure the smooth functioning of the University.

To consider the Minutes of the Rationalization Committee and Roster Committee for further processing of recruitment.

Resolution No.07/87 The minutes of meeting of the Rationalization Committee held on 10.02.2025, approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 28.02.2025 and the minutes of meeting of the Roster committee held on 06.03.30035 were placed before the Executive Council. The Director, FRC gave a detailed PowerPoint presentation of the recommendations of the Roster Committee meeting held on 06.03.2025. The Executive Council gave its nod.

To consider the report of the high-powered fact finding Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor vide Notification No. 05/R/1337/2024 dated 05-09-2024 to enquire into the matter of Dr. Vivek Kumar Dwivedi, Associate Professor, Department of English, and Dr. Vijay Kumar Roy, Associate Professor, Department of English, University of Allahabad.

Resolution No.08/87 The Hon'ble Chairperson of Executive Council read out the recommendation of the high-powered fact finding Committee dated 21.01.2025, on the matter of Dr. Vivek Kumar Dwivedi and Dr. Vijay Kumar Roy (Department of English and MEL) pertaining to their eligibility in the selection committee of Associate Professor, held on 30.03.2022 at the University of Allahabad, quoted verbatim as under:

> 'The Committee is of the opinion that on the basis of documents provided by the University and those submitted by Dr. Vivek Kumar Dwivedi and Dr. Vijay Kumar Roy (Department of English), there is no pertinent ground to question their qualifications at this point of time. The Committee would like to add a caveat that these observations are only for the present time and based on the basis of documents presented on record, if any further information is made available to the University and to the Committee then further decisions may be taken.

> The Committee is unable to comment as to how the Screening Committee overlooked some glaring shortcomings in the application form of Dr. Vivek Kumar Dwivedi. Whether the act of the Screening Committee was deliberate or accidental is not proved.

In light of the above, the apex body may kindly take a suitable decision in the matter.'

The Executive Council, after deliberating on the outcome of the Fact-Finding Committee, unanimously resolved that, there is no sufficient ground to question the qualifications of Dr. Vivek Kumar Dwivedi and Dr. Vijay Kumar Roy. Therefore, the matter will be put on hold until concrete evidence is obtained.

Furthermore, considering the allusion to the functioning of the screening committee in this regard by the Fact-Finding Committee, the Executive Council unanimously resolved that, the members of the then Screening Committee shall not be allowed to be part of any Departmental/University activity in hereafter.

To consider the reply of Dr. Deepshikha Sonkar, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, University of Allahabad in response to the letter no.05/R/1832/2024 dated 08-11-2024 of the Registrar regarding serving of charge sheet dated 04-11-2024, in compliance with the Resolution No.06/86 dated 03-10-2024 of Executive Council.

Resolution No.09/87 The Executive council as Disciplinary Authority examined the single charge framed against Dr. Deepshikha relating to false complaints against the three senior professors of the Department of Economics namely Prof. Manmohan Krishna, Prof. Prahlad Kumar and Mr. Javed Akhtar. The council after the detailed examination of the charge and all other documents mentioned below expressed satisfaction with the framing of the charge.

Documents-

- 1. Copy of the order of the Hon'ble High Court in writ petition no. 38781 of 2016 delivered on 23.02.2024.
- 2. Copy of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 6379/2024 dated 13.05.2024
- 3. Copy of the previous EC resolutions including resolution no.- 06/86 dated 03.10.2024
- 4. Copy of the relevant ordinances mentioned in the charge sheet.

It also looked into the reply given by Dr. Deepshikha to the charge-sheet wherein inter alia she has invited kind attention to various points. In the first point she has stated -

"That the undersigned has not been afforded a copy of the resolution no. 12/83 dated 18.05.2024 whereby which the entire exercise is being purported to be taken. In absence thereof, it would be difficult for the undersigned to acknowledge and appreciate the circumstances, under which such surprising show cause notice has been issued. It is, therefore, earnestly requested that

the copy of the aforesaid resolution be made available to the undersigned as soon as possible.

That however, in compliance of the aforesaid notice a reply in absence of resolution is being submitted before your good self in respect of the charges leveled against the undersigned. However, the undersigned reserve to file a detailed reply in respect of the aforementioned notice once the copy of the aforesaid resolution is made available to her."

The council after going through this point did not peruse the reply further. It was decided that the demanded document should be supplied so that no prejudice is caused to Dr. Deepshikha.

The Executive Council unanimously resolved to authorize the Registrar, University of Allahabad to re-deliver a copy of the charge sheet along with the documents annexed initially and also the demanded document i.e. resolution no. 12/83 dated 18.05.2024 so that Dr. Deepshikha is in a position to file a detailed reply. A time period of 21 days must be given to Dr. Deepshikha to submit a written reply specifically admitting or denying the charge. The reply shall be presented before the Disciplinary Authority in its next meeting which after considering the reply, shall decide whether the enquiry needs to be proceeded with or not.

To consider the reply of Dr. Deepshikha Sonkar, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, University of Allahabad in response to the letter no. 05/R/1826/2024 dated 06-11-2024 of the Registrar regarding furnishing of the copy of the Enquiry report and notice for making a representation on the penalty proposed vide Executive Council Resolution No.07/86 dated 03-10-2024.

Resolution No.10/87 The Executive Council vide its resolution No. 07/86 dated 03.10.2024, in the interest of justice and fairness and compliance of the provisions of the ordinance, offered an opportunity to Dr. Deepshikha to make a representation on the penalty proposed on her. The Registrar was authorized to furnish the copy of the report of the Enquiry Authority including the general and the specific findings on each charge along with the copy of the Resolution No. 07/86 and a notice to Dr. Deepshikha to make a written representation on the Proposed penalty within a period of 21 days after the receipt of notice, to the Registrar. The letter of the registrar bearing no. 05/R/1826/2024 to the same effect was sent on 06.11.2024.

> Dr. Deepshikha asked for extension of time vide email dated 27.11.2024, which was duly granted to her. Her representation has been received vide email dated 30.12.2024.

In her representation Dr. Deepshikha has called the decision of the Executive Council as deeply flawed, illegal, arbitrary, unjust, preconceived and biased. The allegations made by her hold no merit. The decision on the Enquiry report was made after due consideration of report and proper application of mind as is evident from the resolution proposing the penalty.

In her representation Dr. Deepshikha has stated that the decision needs to be rescinded as it tantamounts to willful disobedience of the High court's order dated 24.04.2023. The Council holds unflinching respect for any order/judgement passed by the Hon'ble High court. The inevitable procedural delay in enquiry proceedings was totally unintentional and non-deliberate. Due care was taken to avoid any prejudice to Dr. Deepshikha's interest by following the complete procedure.

It has further been stated that the enquiry was conducted in gross violation of the statutory provisions of Rule 70 of Ordinance L of the university. The enquiry report makes it clear that the provisions of Rule 70 of the Ordinance L were complied with and Dr. Deepshikha was given an adequate and a reasonable opportunity of hearing. No prejudice has been caused to her at any stage.

It has been the case of Dr. Deepshikha that the charge sheet dated 10.07.2023 was issued to her by a retired Professor of the University and the Disciplinary Authority never issued charge-sheet as such the proceedings carried out pursuant to the charge sheet dated 10.07.2023 is void ab initio. It is to be noted that Executive Council never abdicated its responsibility, there is no prohibition in the ordinance in allowing a retired professor to draw a chargesheet.

It is imperative to note that the Executive Council, in its meeting convened on 20.06.2023, resolved to authorize Prof. R.K. Singh (Retd.), formerly of the Department of Commerce and Business Administration, University of Allahabad, to draw and serve a charge sheet upon Dr. Deepshikha, granting a period of fifteen days for submission of her reply. It was further resolved that upon receipt of the reply to the charge sheet, both the charge sheet and the reply would be placed before the Executive Council, which would thereafter consider the matter and decide whether to initiate formal departmental proceedings. The charge-sheet dated 20.06.2023 at this stage was essentially in the nature of show cause notice, purpose of which was to elicit the response of Dr. Deepshikha as to why the disciplinary proceedings be not initiated against her.

Dr. Deepshikha vide her letter dated 25.07.2023, submitted her reply to the charge sheet, whereafter, both the charge sheet and the reply were placed before the Council for its consideration. In its meeting convened on

15.09.2023, as part of Agenda Item No. 04/78, the Executive Council examined the articles of charge contained in the charge sheet and considered the reply submitted by Dr. Deepshikha and after finding the same to be not satisfactory, the Council decided to hold a formal departmental proceeding. Accordingly, the Council appointed an Enquiry Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. Anamika Roy, Department of Ancient History, University of Allahabad.

Thus, the articles of charges contained in the chargesheet were duly examined by the Council and only after being satisfied with the same the decision to initiate the proceedings were taken. Hence, the approval of the Executive Council to the charge-sheet was very much in existence. Since all the articles of charges contained in the charge-sheet dated 10.07.2023 stood approved by the Council in its meeting convened on 15.09.2023, there was no reason to cause a fresh service of the very same chargesheet containing the very same articles of charges.

Dr. Deepshikha has requested for another round of personal hearing. It is imperative to note that the Ordinance does not conceive of providing another round of opportunity of personal hearing at this stage. Moreover, the Council in its wisdom also does not think it necessary to provide another round of opportunity of personal hearing as Dr. Deepshikha has already been offered a full-scale hearing. She has been provided a reasonable and adequate hearing opportunity. The copy of the enquiry report, the EC resolution proposing penalty has been duly furnished to her in order to give her a sufficient chance of representation against the proposed penalty.

Dr. Deepshikha was also provided legible copies of the documents as asked by her in the representation wherein she stated that the present representation is being submitted without prejudice to her right to submit a supplementary/revised representation after receipt of legible copies of few illegible documents) alongwith an additional time of seven days to submit a supplementary/revised representation (vide letter no 05/R/02/2025 dated 02.01.2025)

Dr. Deepshikha has submitted a detailed supplementary representation on 11.01.2025. That representation was also considered. Other than the above contentions, Dr. Deepshikha has stated that the university appointed Dr. R.K. Singh as enquiry officer, she has quoted a letter no. comm. sec/1824/2023 dated 26.06.2023, on inspection of that letter, the Executive Council found that the Registrar has quoted the Executive Council resolution no. 05/75 dated 20/06/2023 and stated that Dr. R.K. Singh has been deputed as Enquiry officer as per the resolution. The Executive Council noted that this was a mistake as the resolution No 05/75 was clear and categorical in its

terms. It only authorized Prof (Dr.) R.K. Singh to draw and serve charge sheet. The Enquiry authority was appointed after the charge sheet was examined vide Executive Council resolution no 04/78 dated 15.09.2023.

Dr. Deepshikha has stated that Enquiry Committee repeatedly declined to supply her copy of daily order sheets. This statement is false as is evident from the page 4 and 5 of the report of the EA that all minutes of the meetings have been provided to her.

As regards to the allegation of illegal innovation of Clause 7(i) of Ordinance XLI it submitted the said Clause has been rightly invoked. Clause 7(i) states "The provisions of Rules 70,71,74,76 and 77 of the rules under ordinance L, shall mutatis mutandis apply to the conduct and procedure of disciplinary proceedings under the provisions of this clause". Dr Deepshikha has quoted an incorrect provision. She has also stated that there was undue delay in supplying the copy of Executive Council resolution dated 15.09.2023, it must be pointed out that all Executive Council resolutions are uploaded on the university website and everyone has open access to them.

As regards the allegation of video recording the proceedings it is pertinent to state that video recording a proceeding is not a violation of any stated procedure. The procedure is intended to afford a fair hearing; Video recording the proceedings of the meetings in no way hampered that. It is important to state that though the proceedings were recorded and this fact is also noted by the Executive council in its resolution no 07/86 dated 03.10.2024, the recording was neither seen nor relied on by the Executive council while making the decision related to penalty. The decision was based solely on the report of the Enquiry authority, copy of which was duly provided to Dr. Deepshikha.

Dr. Deepshikha in her representation has stated that she has been denied the opportunity of engaging a Defence Assistant. She has also stated that the claim made at page 6 of the enquiry report that EA acceded to her request for engaging a retired employee as Defence Assistant, is false and contrary to record. The executive council found that this statement is false as is clear from the letters dated 17/01/2024 and 29/01/2024 at page 226 and 225(annexures)of the Enquiry report respectively. In fact it's clearly stated in the letter dated 29/01/2024 that "...in context of Dr. Deepshikha's request for engaging a retired University employee as Defence Assistant, the matter was approved by the enquiry authority and thereafter only she was asked to provide the consent letter of the employee she wished to engage...". She was again given time to provide the details of the Defence Assistant. The enquiry register also indicates that Dr. Deepshikha was asked to provide the name of the retired employee as a Defence Assistant(p.199 of the enquiry report) In

light of these letters it is clear that Dr. Deepshikha has not represented a true picture.

Dr. Deepshikha has stated that she was denied the inspection of documents by which Articles of charges were proposed to be proved, it must be pointed out that its clearly mentioned on page 11 of the enquiry report that the presenting officer placed the list of Articles of charge and the related documents to Dr. Deepshikha, same can also be seen on page 194, point 2 and point 4 of the enquiry report.

Dr. Deepshikha has stated that the onus to disprove the Article of charge was shifted on her, the enquiry has fulfilled all the requirements of the presenting officer reading the charges(p 9 , point 2 and page 209 point 2), placing the relevant documents(p 11 A.6g. point 1 and page 194, point 2), providing the list of witnesses (page 10, A.6f point 3, page 197 point 3). At page 197, point 3 it has been clearly recorded in minutes that "Presenting officer was allowed to continue his case to which he presented his further role by stating that he would corroborate the list of articles of the chargesheet with the list of witnesses"

The records reveal that the presenting officer did establish the case and gave evidence. Dr. Deepshikha was given adequate opportunity of examining and rebutting the evidence against her. Dr. Deepshikha was given adequate opportunity to put questions in writing to the witnesses.

Dr. Deepshikha has raised an objection on the ground that none of the documents were certified by the Registrar hence they can't be received as prime facie evidence. All the documents which were relied on are official documents. Moreover Dr. Deepshikha asked for legible copies of the documents attached with the enquiry report (attendance register sheets, monthly reports of her absence etc) vide e mail dated 23.12.2024 addressed to the Registrar and the set of legible copies have been sent to her through Registrar vide letter no 05/R/02/2025 dated 02/01/2025. Dr. Deepshikha has filed a supplementary representation after receipt and examination of those copies only. Moreover it is pertinent to state that the two witnesses who have been relied on - office clerk and the Head of the Department are the ones who were mentioned in the charge no. 2. No witness other than these two have been put on record or called.

In response to her First charge Dr. Deepshikha has given the screenshots of 4 online classes dated 07/07/2021, 13/07/2021,21/09/2021 and 11/08/2021, however after the notification dated 13/07/2021 issued by the Registrar teachers were required to be physically present in the faculty. Dr. Deepshikha has admitted knowledge of the notifications issued by the Registrar (page nos. 9 Point 3(a), 207 and 208 Point 2(a) of enquiry report). The classes after

the notification dated 13/07/2021 had to be conducted from the faculty, which Dr. Deepshikha has failed to do as is clear from non-signing of the attendance register. Charge 1 stands proved.

In response to Charge 2, Dr. Deepshikha has annexed a true copy of the joining report dated 18/04/2022 bearing signed acknowledgement by the office of department of Economics. However, it was this document only which was under contest. In the chargesheet as well it was clearly stated "You had sent a letter through a messenger wherein you had expressed your intention to join the department after 3 days but you did not join physically. You are claiming that you have joined the department on 18/04/2022. The clerk on duty informed the Head of Department that the said letter was handed over to him by a research scholar named Mr. Wamik Khan and the clerk has made a written statement to that effect."

The clerk and the Head of Department were called as a witness and they made the same statements. Their testimony could not be impeached by Dr. Deepshikha. Additionally, non-signing of attendance register from 16/04/2022 till 26/04/2023 and also the letters of the HOD reporting her monthly absence in addition the monthly reports wherein Dr. Deepshikha was shown as absent without notice w.e.f 16.04.2022 are also on record. The evidences establish the charges, hence the charge was rightly considered to be proved in the report.

In response to charge 3, Dr. Deepshikha has stated that she submitted her reply dated 21.09.2022. The reply to the letter was not put on record by the presenting officer, hence the Executive Council considers this charge as not proved. On perusal of the reply it is apparent that nowhere Dr. Deepshikha has explained anything related to the show cause issued by the Registrar instead she asked for an explanation from the Registrar as to why the show cause was sent on her permanent address. In effect that is not the reply to the show cause. Moreover the second letter dated 21.09.2022 was addressed by Dr. Deepshikha to the Vice Chancellor and not the Registrar. Whatever the case may be the reply to the letter was not put on record by the presenting officer, hence the Executive Council considers this charge as not proved.

EC resolution no 07/86 dated 03.10.2024 stated as follows-

"the misconduct of Dr. Deepshikha stands proved on accounts of all three charges i.e. misconduct under conjoint reading of clauses 6(a) and (b) and clauses 8(a) and (b) of Ordinance XLI and under clause 7(h) conjointly read with clause 6(a) of the ordinance XLI in respect of charge 1, Misconduct under clause 8(b)(ii) of ordinance XLIII in respect of charge 2 and misconduct under clause 7(h) conjointly read with clause 6(a) of ordinance XLI in respect of charge 3 stand proved.

Charge 1 and charge 2 jointly as well as severally are serious enough to warrant termination under clause 8 of Ordinance XLI, Considering the severity of misconduct, clear mandate of clause 8 (b)of the ordinance XLI and holding that there are no mitigating circumstances the following major Penalty is proposed-

Termination of the service of Dr. Deepshikha Sonkar under clause 8(b) of Ordinance XLIII(leave rules for teachers of the University and Constituent colleges) and under rule 67(viii) of part III(penalties and Disciplinary Authorities) of the Schedule to Ordinance L.

The Executive council as has already resolved before that charge 1 and 2 which stand proved jointly as well as severally are serious enough to warrant termination.

It has lastly been contended by Dr. Deepshikha that proposed penalty of termination of service is disproportionate and excessive particularly in view of the fact that the University had earlier imposed the penalty of stoppage of five annual increments with cumulative effect. What has thus been urged is that her situation cannot be made worse, in as much as had she accepted the punishment and not raised demur, no occasion would have arisen for the University to impose the punishment of termination.

The members of the Executive Council were unanimous that the aforesaid assertion raised by Dr. Deepshikha is required to be considered by the University dispassionately. Accordingly, the University has given a thoughtful consideration to this aspect and finds that firstly the Executive Council must juxtapose the nature of established misconduct and its ramification qua University.

The members of the Executive Council are unanimous in observing that the primary purpose of the University is to impart quality education through structured academic programs. The unauthorized absence not only derails the pedagogical process but also undermines the academic credibility of the institution. Universities thrive on discipline, regularity, and adherence to academic norms. When teachers — who are meant to be the custodians of academic excellence — engage in unauthorized absence, it sends a damaging signal to students and junior faculty, eroding the culture of discipline and responsibility. Universities are not just workplaces; they are learning communities where every member's conduct shapes the institutional ethos. A teacher's indiscipline, therefore, multiplies its impact across the entire academic environment. Unauthorized absence of teachers results in poor feedback from students, reduced teaching hours, and compromised academic processes, all of which negatively affect the University's reputation and ability

to attract talented students and faculty. Thus, unauthorized absence constitutes a grave misconduct.

The Executive Council called for the records of the previous meeting dated 23.03.2023 and examined the same. The members of the Executive Council are in unison that the deleterious consequences emanating from unauthorized absence was underappreciated by the Council in its previous meeting dated 23.03.2023. The misconduct of unauthorized absence affecting public interest, institutional integrity, and trust was not properly factored in by the Council. The Executive Council also did not examine the aspect that leniency in serious cases, such as prolonged unauthorized absence, sets a dangerous precedent for other employees.

Considering the wide-ranging detrimental effects, the Executive Council is completely justified in imposing the punishment of dismissal for the established misconduct of unauthorized absence. Since Dr. Deepshikha has been given an opportunity to make a representation on the proposed penalty of termination, appropriate opportunity has been given to her and thus no prejudice is being caused to her.

In view of the above, after due deliberation the Executive Council unanimously resolves -that there exits good and sufficient reasons to impose punishment of termination from service. It is unanimously resolved to uphold the penalty as proposed vide Executive Council resolution no 07/86 dated 03.10.2024. Dr. Deepshikha's service stands terminated, with immediate effect. Dr. Deepshikha will not be entitled to any salary or allowances or any other benefits in any form from the University post termination of her service. Past dues, if any, shall be paid to her as per rules. Intimation of termination to Dr. Deepshikha be made by the Registrar vide e-mail and post forthwith.
