

Brief Note:

On 30 January 2022, Gandhiji's death anniversary was commemorated by the Institute of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies, Allahabad University. Special guest Prof. Sudhir Chandra offered his tribute and flowers at the statue of Gandhiji installed in the Institute of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies. Prof. Manmohan Krishna Ji garlanded and a tree was also planted in the garden by him. The special guest also presented books based on the life of Gandhiji to Divya and Anamika, two students of Allahabad University who made Rangoli in Gandhi Mandapam. During this event, the director of the institute, Prof. Santosh Bhadauria, Prof. Dhananjay Yadav, Prof. N. B Singh, Prof. Ajay Jaitley, All the employees of the institute and Prof. Shabnam Hameed, Dr. Avinash Srivastava, Dr. Rajesh Singh, Dr. Akhilesh Pal, Dr. Dhirendra Pratap Singh 'Dhawal', Dr. Mrityunjay Rao Parmar were present.

On this occasion, the institute also organized an online lecture on Google Meet. In which the welcome address was given by Prof. Santosh Bhadauria. While giving the inaugural statement, Vice Chancellor of Allahabad University, Prof. Sangeeta Srivastava said that Gandhi's personal contempt had become a social conflict in South Africa. Gandhiji will always be known as a timeless personality. She said that only the continuation of Gandhi's ideas of Sarvodaya, Service, Swadeshi, and Cleanliness will continue to realize the real meaning of independence. She further elaborates that even the last man will have to accept non-violence, discipline, and self-reliance in order to make a better Indian society.

The keynote speaker. Prof. Sudhir Chandra from Delhi expressed his views boldly on the topic 'Gandhi's Concept of India'. Prof. Sudhir Chandra said I am very happy that I have been a student of Allahabad University from 1958-1960. Even today, no one wants to miss an opportunity to join this university. Sudhir Chandra ji is the author of an important book like Gandhi: Ek Asambhav Sambhavna. Talking about Gandhi, he further said that there was widespread mourning over Gandhi's death. Also, the significance of any event based on Gandhiji will not be achieved by big empty talks on Gandhiji. If any of Gandhi's ideas offend anyone, then the person who is talking about those ideas will have to be stopped. Gandhi talked about saving nature, we are trampling nature. Instead of nature, they are becoming satisfied with the pure air and water provided by science. They are destroying the economy of villages, indulging in communal frenzy, and saying that we have to follow Gandhi's path. Talking about Gandhi, he said that in the last moments of his life, Gandhi had said, I aspired to live for 125 years, now I don't want to live even for 80, may God take me now. The thing to think about is that Gandhi had lost his desire to live in a free country.

Sudhir ji urged the audience not to prove themselves as soldiers of Gandhi's Marg if it was not possible in all aspects of life. He also said that today instead of talking about Gandhi, there is a need to understand him. Villages will have to be brought into a central role. We have to understand the difference between democracy and monarchy. Nature must be conserved. This online lecture was conducted by Dr. Amrita from the Hindi Department and technical support was provided by Translation Officer Hariom Kumar and Dr. Dhirendra Pratap Singh 'Dhawal'. Many senior teachers and many researchers and students of Allahabad University participated in this lecture.





Brief Note:

On the occasion of International Women's Day, a special lecture on the topic 'Mahatma Gandhi and Women's Voice' was organized on the digital platform of the Institute of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies of Allahabad University. While giving the welcome address Director of the Institute Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies, Prof. Santosh Bhadauria discussed the background of International Women's Day, Prof. Santosh Bhadauria said that Women's Day is the day of women empowerment. Mahatma Gandhi took the charkha to every home for women's empowerment. Indian Women supported every movement of Mahatma Gandhi. The first guru is always a woman in some form or the other. Today is the era of women's empowerment.

Keynote speaker Dr. Chitra Mali, from Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University, regional center Kolkata, spoke on the topic 'Mahatma Gandhi and Women's Voice'. While giving a statement, she said that Mahatma Gandhi's tools like non-violence, truth, fasting, Satyagraha, and non-violent resistance are called feminist tools. Women played an important role in all the movements of Gandhi whether it was the Satyagraha or non-cooperation movement. Describing the struggle of women in a step-by-step manner, she emphasized modern era is the women's empowerment era. Reiterating the words of Mahatma Gandhi, she said that Gandhiji was right in saying that women are most oppressed at the level of marriage. The dowry system etc. can be stopped only when there are inter-caste marriages. It is wrong for parents to force their daughters to marry and it is even worse not to make them capable of earning a living. Dr. Chitra Mali further said that today is a day to remember those women who fought for women's equality and their rights. On this occasion, the results of various competitions of International Mother Language Day 2021, Ekta Diwas, 2021, and Gandhi Week 2022 were also announced. Prakash Kumar got first place in the letter-writing competition organized during Gandhi Week, while Satya Prakash Shukla got first place in the then speech competition. Shalini Kushwaha and Ritesh Gupta got the first prize in poster making and essay writing respectively. In the Ekta Diwas competitions organized under Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, Shivani Mishra and Anurag Tiwari

got first place in poster making and self-composed poetry writing respectively, while Mita Pandey got first prize in slogan writing.

_____ Under the joint auspices of Allahabad University's Institute of Gandhian Thought & Peace Studies and Central Cultural Committee, a poster exhibition dedicated to martyrs and a Special lecture on Shaheed Bhagat Singh in Gandhi's view was organized at Gandhi Bhawan. Under the direction of Professor Ajay Jaitley, Chairman of the Department of Visual Arts, Allahabad University, fifty hand-made colourful paintings made by the students of the Visual Arts Department were displayed. He had said that Bhagat Singh was not a priest of non-violence but did not consider violence as his religion. Salute to the bravery of those heroes who overcame even the fear of death. Bhagat Singh certainly disagreed with Gandhi's philosophy and thoughts in many places, but he always respected Gandhi. In the presidential address, Prof. Ashish Saxena said that we need to stop seeing Gandhi and Bhagat Singh in binary. Gandhi and Bhagat Singh were moving forward with the same goal and not against each other for the country. Humanity at the center of Gandhi and Bhagat Singh Was. This is the reason why Bhagat Singh did not use the deadly bomb in a crowded court. We have to always keep in mind the sacrifices of the martyrs and their objectives. During the lecture. Gandhi and Premchand are the two eyes of history: Rajendra Kumar

Keynote speaker, senior poet & critic Prof. Rajendra Kumar said that Premchand and Gandhi were almost contemporaries. There is no reference to any meeting between Premchand and Gandhi. Premchand never meets Gandhi but meets his thoughts. After Tulsidas, the person who became most popular was Gandhi. Premchand not only assimilated Gandhi but assimilated Vivekananda also in his writings Gandhi appears in Balaji of the novel Vardaan. The range of Premchand's eyes was so wide that all the wise men were present in his eyes. Vivekananda said that the people here understand something only when it is expressed in religious idioms and symbols. This is the reason why Gandhi's concept of Ramrajya has been taken from Tulsidas. Rajendra ji said that as Tulsi wrote, 'Ram Bharat is more than two eyes'. Premchand and Gandhi are the two eyes of history.

When we look at Premchand in the light of Gandhi, we come to know that there are many shades of Gandhi in Premchand. Premchand did not accept any single influence of Gandhi.

Both Gandhi and Premchand had said, my political guru is Gokhale. Premchand had written an article on Gokhale in *Zamana*. Premchand was a supporter of the extremist group. The strength to see Premchand was coming from many places. Premchand's eyes do not look straight but all around. He wrote in 1919, I have become a believer in Bolshevik principles. After the Gaya controversy of Congress, he had said that I do not belong to any party, I am a member of a party which has not been formed yet. Premchand's Kalpana party has not been formed yet. I am the nightingale of a garden which does not exist yet. Premchand was learning from Gandhi. Premchand was not a complete advocate of non-violence, he said in one of his stories, *Duniya ka Anmol Ratan*, that a drop of blood that can be useful to the country is the world's priceless gem. Many threads of Gandhism are present in Premchand's novels and stories. But, Gandhism is not a path to which Premchand is tied. Gandhi and Premchand are also the eyes of Urdu and Hindi. Gandhi is the name of a typical Hindustani and Premchand is the name of a typical Hindustani poet.

Gandhi overcame all evils. The quality of great leaders or litterateurs is to be a visionary and this quality was present in Premchand and Gandhi. The journey of Gandhi and Premchand was to establish an egalitarian society. We should take light from wherever we can. Gandhiji was certainly a soldier of politics but he was also very strong with the pen. Gandhi should also be evaluated as a writer. Premchand was not only a writer but also engaged in social causes.

Brief Note:

05 September 2022/Gandhi Bhawan: A special lecture on the topic of Gandhi's Nai Talim and the 21st Century was held in the Gandhi Mandapam of the Institute of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies, University of Allahabad. A famous Gandhian teacher was the special speaker. Prof. PK Sahoo talked in detail about Gandhi's Basic Education or Nai Taalim. The program was presided over by Prof. P.K Ghosh for the Department of Economics at the University. Welcome Statement was given by Director of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies Institute, Prof. Santosh Bhadauria and he said that study of Gandhi's life is the best education. The event was conducted by Dr. Amrita, Assistant Professor of Hindi department. On the occasion of this lecture, the guests also planted saplings along with the Director of the Institute.

Pro. PK Sahoo in his lecture elaborates that Gandhiji's philosophy of education was about emphasizing purity of conscience. He said that unless internal development is linked with the community, society, and country, it will be selfish development. Gandhiji was not against science, English, and mathematics, but he believed that mental and cognitive development achieved through education should be linked with internal and spiritual development. In Nai-Talim the emphasis was on how to learn rather than what to learn. Awakening of self-power is necessary. There is a need to understand the inner experience. Gandhiji established Gujarat Vidyapeeth so that the real meaning of education could be known. Mother tongue and dialect should be given a place in primary education. More emphasis should be given to the mother tongue. Formative and creative education should be kept at the center. Attention should be given to inclusive education. To awaken one's self-power one has to go through various experiences. A good education will be achieved


only when both the teacher and the learner are fearless. One has to be free from being dependent. An education where all learners feel free. Education that promotes morality is true education. The curriculum has to be linked to the needs of daily life. Creation of self-supporting educational institutions.

Dependence on others for freedom destroys freedom. The neoliberal education system in this respect is the exact opposite of Gandhi's Nai-Talim because in Gandhi's Nai-Talim the self of freedom is safe and effective. In the 21st century, only Gandhian ideology can replace the neo-liberal system. Gandhi's Nai-Talim talks about empowerment. It is a matter of the development of non-violence. The relationship between teacher and learner is not one of order and compliance but of mutuality. Both inspire and influence each other. Linking character development to skill development. It is a matter of sustainability.

Prof. P.K Ghosh in his speech talked about assimilating the practical form of education. He remembered the teacher who was the father of ORS solution. He talked about making education useful and functional. On this occasion Prof. Saleha Rasid, All the students and employees of Gandhian Institute, including Prof. S.P. Shukla, Praveen Shekhar, Amitesh Kumar, Rajesh Singh, Dr. Dhirendra Dhawal, Rahul Kumar, Karan, Satyam, Srishti, Pushkar, Nishant and Hariom Kumar from the Official Language Section were present.


On 28 September, a poster-making competition related to Mahatma Gandhi was organized for the students of Allahabad University and constituent colleges.

Symbols of all religions will be found in Gandhi's thoughts. He was a follower of all religions, Hindu, Muslim, Sikh, and Christian. Gandhi himself had admitted that if we had to choose between violence and inaction, I would choose violence. Gandhi did a lot of work for the liberation of Dalits.

The keynote speaker of the program, senior critic and editor, Professor Shambhu Nath said that Gandhi was a skilled artisan. If I have to connect with Gandhi, I would like to connect at a close distance. Gandhi was a critic of both antiquity and newness. They achieve distance from both antiquity and contemporaneity. Gandhi laid the foundation of Sabarmati Ashram in 1916 and gave place to Dalits in that ashram. Tilak wrote Geeta-Rahasya and Gandhi wrote the book on Geeta. Mahatma Gandhi is the greatest synthesis of his time. Gandhi took the metaphor of Ramrajya from Tulsidas. His concept of Ramrajya was to unite the society, not to divide it. Gandhi took the charkha from Kabir. Gandhiji chooses symbols from the Bhakti movement. Vedanta, Buddhist philosophy, the Bhakti movement, renaissance, and globalization are five big moments of life. Blind intellectualism is very dangerous for democracy. Due to this our expression becomes surrendered. When someone's statue is being demolished at night, it should be understood that thoughts of violence are coming alive again. Gandhi acted with both wisdom and honesty. Hinduism means the continuous search for truth. In 1947, Gandhi's book 'India of my dreams' was published, and he wrote in it that inequality is increasing in India. Whenever there has been a stir in the society, the walls have been broken. Gandhi thought a lot about Asia but why is there most violence in Asia? Both Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore look like two banks of a river. Both Gandhi and Rabindra are on the banks of the same river. This is in the case of Gandhi vs Ambedkar. Gandhi did not believe in the clash of civilizations. Gandhi believed in dialogue between civilizations.

Ambedkar never considered Gandhi as his enemy. He said that Gandhiji is not our enemy, he is the opposition. Gandhiji said that castes are a burden on the Hindu religion. I have never rejected the Varnashram system, I have always tried to eradicate untouchability. Gandhi always broke himself so that he could unite India. Eminent and senior poet Naresh Saxena expressed his views on the extreme passivity prevalent in society at present and said that one should have the strength to call truth as truth and lie as lie. The guests were welcomed by the director of the institute, Prof. Santosh Bhadauria. The event was conducted by Hariom Kumar. 



Institute of Gandhian Thought & Peace Studies organized a World Water Day event on 22nd March 2024 from 1100 am, onwards in the Institute's Kasturba Gandhi Seminar Hall. methods. He quoted case studies from Kol & Jaunsari tribes and lauded the local traditions of saving water for future generations.
