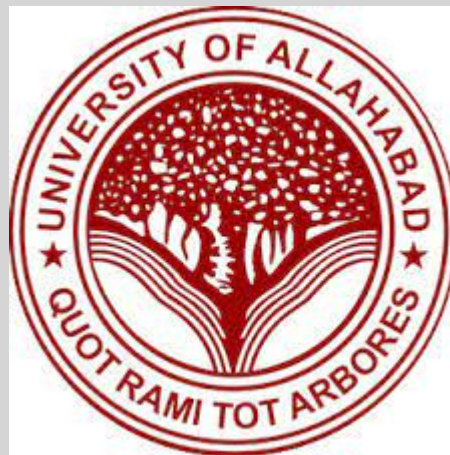

Many literature lovers, Sanjay Pandey, Riyaz Khan, and Dr. Shamenaz Shaikh. Many young Scholars including Dr. Varsha Aggarwal, Aarti Chirag, Brijesh Kumar, Karan, and Kunjbihari were present.

Gandhi and Premchand are the two eyes of history: Rajendra Kumar

Keynote speaker, senior poet & critic Prof. Rajendra Kumar said that Premchand and Gandhi were almost contemporaries. There is no reference to any meeting between Premchand and Gandhi. Premchand never meets Gandhi but meets his thoughts. After Tulsidas, the person who became most popular was Gandhi. Premchand not only assimilated Gandhi but assimilated Vivekananda also in his writings Gandhi appears in Balaji of the novel Vardaan. The range of Premchand's eyes was so wide that all the wise men were present in his eyes. Vivekananda said that the people here understand something only when it is expressed in religious idioms and symbols. This is the reason why Gandhi's concept of Ramrajya has been taken from Tulsidas. Rajendra ji said that as Tulsi wrote, 'Ram Bharat is more than two eyes'. Premchand and Gandhi are the two eyes of history.

When we look at Premchand in the light of Gandhi, we come to know that there are many shades of Gandhi in Premchand. Premchand did not accept any single influence of Gandhi.

Both Gandhi and Premchand had said, my political guru is Gokhale. Premchand had written an article on Gokhale in *Zamana*. Premchand was a supporter of the extremist group. The strength to see Premchand was coming from many places. Premchand's eyes do not look straight but all around. He wrote in 1919, I have become a believer in Bolshevik principles. After the Gaya controversy of Congress, he had said that I do not belong to any party, I am a member of a party which has not been formed yet. Premchand's Kalpana party has not been formed yet. I am the nightingale of a garden which does not exist yet. Premchand was learning from Gandhi. Premchand was not a complete advocate of non-violence, he said in one of his stories, *Duniya ka Anmol Ratan*, that a drop of blood that can be useful to the country is the world's priceless gem. Many threads of Gandhism are present in Premchand's novels and stories. But, Gandhism is not a path to which Premchand is tied. Gandhi and Premchand are also the eyes of Urdu and Hindi. Gandhi is the name of a typical Hindustani and Premchand is the name of a typical Hindustani poet.

Gandhi overcame all evils. The quality of great leaders or litterateurs is to be a visionary and this quality was present in Premchand and Gandhi. The journey of Gandhi and Premchand was to establish an egalitarian society. We should take light from wherever we can. Gandhiji was certainly a soldier of politics but he was also very strong with the pen. Gandhi should also be evaluated as a writer. Premchand was not only a writer but also engaged in social causes.

Brief Note:

On the Sixth day of Gandhi Saptah, the closing ceremony of Gandhi Saptah and the foundation day of The Institute of Gandhian Thought and Peace Studies was celebrated on 6 February 2024. The chief guest for this event were honourable Vice-Chancellor Prof. Sangeeta Srivastava and Honourable Registrar of the University Prof. N.K. Shukla and special guest for this event were famous Gandhian activist Mrs Santosh Goiendi ji.

The event started with a visit of guests to the exhibition organised by the Regional Centre of the National Archive and the Institute. The exhibition reflected Gandhi ji's contribution and freedom struggle in various media platforms and Posters. Later all chief guests wrote their messages on posters as tribute to Gandhi's contribution.

In her views about books that were translated by the National Book Trust and through certain stories of those books, she tried to express that we have to learn many things from our stories, our folklore as knowledge. Every story tells us something and books are the greatest medium to learn. In the last part of her speech, she urged everyone to buy and read books.

The honourable guest and Gandhian activist Mrs. Santosh Goeindi ji in her speech thanked her Alma matter Allahabad University and also applauded the Vice-chancellor for being the first female Vice-Chancellor of Allahabad University. Through an incident of the meeting of Mahatma Gandhi and J.B. Kripalani, she explained how the inner consciousness of every being is pure and Gandhi always tried to change that through his Satyagraha. She also explained and criticized that through certain structural tactics, Britishers somehow made us think to be inferior beings, and Gandhi through his non-violence and Satyagraha transformed that view and made us believe that we are equal, capable, and potential human beings. At the end of her speech, she urges all of us to be like Gandhi in some respects.

The vote of thanks was delivered by Register Prof. N.K. Shukla and as the last part of the event a Gandhi bhajan "Raghupati Raghav Raja Ram" was presented by the Music Department. This event was conducted by Dr. Toshi Anand.

Institute of Gandhian Thought & Peace Studies organized **World Mother Language Day** on 21st February 2024 from 01:30 pm, onwards in Gandhi Mandapam with Collaboration of Rajbhasha Cell of the University of Allahabad

The Event started with a floral tribute to Mahatma Gandhi in Gandhi Mandapam by all the invited guests. The Official event commenced with the Convener of the Official Language Implementation Committee and Director of Gandhi Bhavan, Professor Santosh Bhadauria ji, presenting a book and flower bouquet to the Chairman of the Official Language Implementation Committee and Registrar of Allahabad University, Professor Narendra Kumar Shukla and President Yash Malviya ji and invited poets of different languages.

Professor Santosh Kumar Bhadauria in his welcome speech said that organizing Mother Language Day by the United Nations is an important concept. Today, languages are declining all over the world. In such a situation, it is the responsibility of all conscious societies to develop mother languages which are symbols of knowledge, culture, and heritage. Referring to his mother tongue Bundeli, he talked about keeping the mother tongues alive.

Registrar of Allahabad University and Chairman of the Official Language Implementation Committee, Professor Narendra Kumar Shukla said that we should never avoid our mother tongues. Whenever we get an opportunity, we must speak our mother tongue. Many times your mother tongue does the work for you which other languages cannot do. With a memoir, he put forward the power of his mother tongue before everyone. He also said that it is a pleasant experience that the Official Language Section has been celebrating International Mother Language Day for the last 7 years continuously.

On this occasion, “Diary 2024” of the Official Language Section of Allahabad University was released by the guests to give momentum to the Official Language Office. This diary of the Official Language Section contains the contact details of all the administrative officers of Allahabad University, and the contact details of the

Dean, Director Head. To help the personnel, Official Language Act 1963, Official Language Rule 197,6 standard spelling, English Hindi synonyms, precious thoughts of great men.

On 24 February 2024 Famous cartoonist Abid Surti ji visited the Institute of Gandhian Thought & Peace Studies and shared his views about Gandhi and Water Awareness. On his visit, he said, “This is not Gandhi Bhavan but a place of love, peace, and goodwill”.

He also shared an interesting incident of his grandmother’s meeting with Gandhi ji. “When Gandhiji used to go on trips and had meetings somewhere, a crowd of people used to wait for him... He used to walk very fast and leave... At that time, my grandmother was also waiting for him wearing a burqa. Seeing my grandmother in the crowd, he came towards her and folded his hands rapidly and shook them as he used to do Amul... He paused for a while and then quickly moved ahead. This was my grandmother's achievement. Everyone has their own achievement. That short meeting with Gandhiji was my grandmother’s achievement.” the occasion was started with floral tributes to Mahatma Gandhi at Gandhi Bhawan, Allahabad University. He further said that at that time the Muslim women of our locality used to wear burqa and go to learn and spin the charkhas set up by Gandhiji for Swadeshi. All this was his achievement.

On this occasion, the Head of the Department of Visual Arts, at Allahabad University, Ajay Jaitley said that Surti Ji is not only a cartoonist but a great painter. A painter is exactly like a litterateur when he writes poetry, he writes poetry, no matter how great a novelist he is.

Director of the institute Prof. Santosh Bhadauria ji, offered a token of appreciation in the form of a book and souvenirs to the esteemed guest, After paying floral tributes at the Gandhi Mandapam, respected Surti ji looked closely at the exhibition and posters of the institute and said that it is a good thing that Gandhi is being kept in front of the people through various mediums. After reviewing the visitor's book of the institute, he recorded his thoughts in it. He

expressed his happiness that it is a great thing that even in today's times, students are visiting this campus and participating in various creative programs.
