INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES APPEARING IN OMR BASED EXAM

- 1. Please bring the Admit Card and THREE photographs** (similar to uploaded in the application form by you) in original.
- You have to submit the office copy of the admit card to the room invigilator during the exam.
- You are advised to report to the examination venue at the time mentioned on the Admit Card. *Note: Candidate will not be allowed to enter the examination venue after Gate Closure Time.*
- Candidate without Admit card and Valid Photo ID Proof (Aadhar Card/Pass Port/Driving License/PAN Card) shall not be allowed in the Examination under any circumstances by the Centre superintendent.**
- Candidate shall not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the conclusion of the examination and without handing over the OMR Answer Sheet and Test Booklet to the Invigilator concerned.
- Candidate should check and ensure that the Test Booklet contains as many numbers of pages as written on the top of the cover page.
- Candidate shall not remove any page(s) from the Test Booklet and if any page(s) is/are found missing from his/her Test Booklet, he/she may be liable for suitable action.
- Candidate should bring good quality blue/black ball point pens for the examination.** Use of Pencil, Ink/Sketch Pen or Gel Pen is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- Candidate should use blue/black ball point pen only to write particulars on the cover page of Test Booklet, OMR and for darkening the circles of responses. Darken ONLY ONE CIRCLE for each answer as shown in the example below. If you darken more than one circle, that answer will not be evaluated.
- The candidate should ensure that he/she has darkened the circle providing information on the Roll Number, Test booklet number, Centre code & Question paper series in the OMR Sheet.
- Pencil, Calculators, Log tables, calculating devices or any other electronic devices, Communication Devices like Cellular/Smart Phone/Pager etc. and textual materials is strictly prohibited in the examination Centre. No whitener/eraser/blade is allowed for changing answers.
- If a candidate is in possession of cellular/Smart Phone/Pager or any other electronic device during the exam, the same will be forfeited and his/her candidature may be cancelled.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES APPEARING IN COMMON ENTRANCE TEST – 2022 FOR ADMISSION IN DACE AU

1. Candidates are required to follow the rules, regulations and guidelines of University of Allahabad; Local Authorities, State Government and Government of India especially related to COVID19 as issued from time to time.
2. Candidates should maintain social distance while commuting to and from the examination centre and from the time of entry at examination centre till the exit from the examination centre.
3. Candidates should carry soap/hand sanitiser of up to 50 ml in a transparent bottle, face mask and water in a transparent bottle for personal use.
4. Candidates should not share personal items like mask, gloves, water bottle, etc.
5. It is mandatory to wear a face mask properly at all times.
6. Spitting is strictly prohibited.
