# THE REPORTED SHIP

# गाँधी विचार एवं शांति अध्ययन संस्थान

महात्मा गांधी का सम्पूर्ण वैचारिक विमर्श व्यक्ति के सामाजिक और आध्यात्मिक उन्नयन पर आधारित था। उक्त बातें दिनांक 20 दिसम्बर 2024 को गांधी विचार एवं शांति अध्ययन संस्थान के कस्तूरबा गांधी सभागार में प्रो. जे. एस. माथुर स्मृति व्याख्यान माला के अंतर्गत "स्वच्छता पर गांधी परिप्रेक्ष : एक परिचर्चा " विषय पर अपने व्याख्यान में बोलते हुए मुख्य वक्ता के रूप में इलाहाबाद विश्वविद्यालय के समाजशास्त्र विभाग के अध्यक्ष एवं एफ.आर.सी. के चेयरमैन प्रो. आशीष सक्सेना ने कही। उन्होनें आगे कहा कि महात्मा गांधी ऐसे कर्मयोगी थे जो पीड़ित मानवता के समुचित उद्धार के लिए सत्य, अहिंसा और सत्याग्रह पर आधारित कर्म क्षेत्र के माध्यम से अपना सर्वश्रेस्ठ प्रयास कर रहे थे। प्रो. आशीष नें आगे कहा कि महात्मा गांधी कि सम्पूर्ण कार्य तकनीक भारतवर्ष कि समृद्ध ऐतिहासिक विरासत मूल्यों और लक्ष्यों कि पुनरावृत्ति है। प्रो सक्सेना नें आगे कहा कि गांधी का सामाजिक सुधार का कार्य विशेषकर वंचितों, शोषितों और अछूतोद्धार पर केन्द्रित था। उन्होनें सामाजिक समरसता और समाज में एकत्व भाव कि स्थापना के लिए विभिन्न प्रयासों और तकनीक का सफल सदुपयोग किया। उदाहरण के स्वरूप महात्मा गांधी पहले ऐसे सामाजिक व्यक्ति है, जिन्होनें अछूतों के सुधार तथा उन्हों सम्मान के साथ विकास कि मुख्य धारा में स्थापित करने का प्रयास किया।

व्याख्यान माला में विशिष्ट वक्ता के रूप में गांधी और पर्यावरण: जल संकट के विषय पर अपना उद्बोधन देते हुए चौधरी महादेव प्रसाद पी जी कॉलेज के रसायनशास्त्र विभाग के डॉ प्रमोद शर्मा नें कहा कि लगातार बढ़ती जनसंख्या और असंयमित उपभोग के कारण जल का संकट पूरी दुनिया में बढ़ा है। भारत इससे अछूता नहीं। संयुक्त राष्ट्र के सतत विकास लक्ष्य में पेयजल उपलब्ध कराना भी एक प्रमुख मुद्दा है आंकड़े बताते है की भूजल का स्तर लगातार गिर रहा है, रिचार्ज की तुलना में यदि समय रहते हम नहीं चेते तो एक दिन धरती नें यदि यह कह दिया कि हमारे पास जल ही नहीं है।



व्याख्यान में विषय प्रवर्तन करते हुए संस्थान के समन्वयक डॉ अविनाश कुमार श्रीवास्तव नें कहा कि महात्मा गांधी का संपूर्ण जीवन विमर्श अत्यंत वैविध्यपूर्ण है और उसमें मानव जीवन की सभी समस्याओं पर विचार किया गया। डॉ श्रीवास्तव नें आगे कहा कि विकास के वर्तमान परिवेश में आज सबसे बड़ी समस्या जलवायु नैतिकी, मानव गरिमा और सामाजिक संदर्भों की है। ये अजीब संयोग है कि पृथ्वी के ¾ हिस्सों में पानी है लेकिन हम सबको बोतल बंद पानी खरीदकर पीने के लिए विवश होना पड़ रहा है। डॉ अविनाश नें आगे कहा कि महात्मा गांधी नें इस संकट को पहचान लिया था और आगे कहा था कि "आज विकास तो हो रहा है लेकिन वस्तुओं का न कि व्यक्तियों का" डॉ श्रीवास्तव नें आगे कहा कि प्रकृति के अनैतिक अतार्किक और अंधाधुंध दोहन का दुष्परिणाम है कि आज हमारे सम्मुख स्वच्छता, स्वास्थ्य और पर्यावरण से संबन्धित गंभीर संकट खड़े हो गए है और यदि समय रहते हमने इसका समुचित समाधान न दिया तो मानवीय अस्तित्व पर प्रश्न चिन्ह लग जाएगा।

### **Department of Education**



# दर्शनशास्र विभाग

दर्शनशास्र विभाग द्वारा आयोजित एवं भारतीय दार्शनिक अनुसंधान परिषद्, नई दिल्ली द्वारा प्रायोजित आवधिक व्याख्यान माला का प्रथम व्याख्यान शुक्रवार को राम नाथ कौल, पुस्तकालय, दर्शनशास्र विभाग में संपन्न हुआ। व्याख्याता दर्शनशास्र विभाग, इलाहाबाद विश्वविद्यालय के पूर्व अध्यक्ष प्रो॰ एच॰ एस॰ उपाध्याय थे। व्याख्यान का विषय: ज्ञानमीमांसा और इसकी समस्याएं: पाश्चात्य दर्शन के विशेष संदर्भ में था। प्रो॰ उपाध्याय ने कहा भारतीय और पाश्चात्य दर्शनों के मूल में ज्ञानमीमांसा है। भारतीय दर्शन में सांख्य आदि दर्शन यह कहते हैं कि केवल एक ही दर्शन है, वह ख्याति है, विवेक है। दर्शन पुरुष और प्रकृति, चेतना और जड़ के मध्य भेद का ज्ञान है। वहीं पाश्चात्य जगत में दर्शन की परिभाषा ही ज्ञान के प्रति प्रेम के रूप में की गई। उन्होंने कहा कि भारतीय दर्शन में ज्ञान को सही और गलत दोनों रूपों में विभाजित किया गया, जिसे क्रमशः प्रमा और अप्रमा कहते हैं, जबिक पाश्चात्य जगत में ज्ञान गलत नहीं होता, वह सही होता है। उन्होंने प्लेटो से लेकर डेकार्ट, ह्यूम, मूर, रसल, विट्गेन्स्टाइन, कॉलपापर, राइल जैसे मतों पर प्रकाश डालते हुए कहा कि ज्ञान के अनेक स्तर हो सकते हैं, अनेक कसौटियां हो सकती हैं। प्रो॰ उपाध्याय ने ए. डी. बूजले के उस मत का खंडन किया जिसमें वे कहते हैं कि ज्ञानमीमांसा शब्द ही गलत है।



कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता कर रहे दर्शनशास्त्र विभाग, इलाहाबाद विश्वविद्यालय के पूर्व अध्यक्ष प्रो॰ जटाशंकर ने कहा कि प्लेटो के द्वारा कही हुई बात का सादृश्य महाकवि कालिदास की रचनाओं में दिखता है। उन्होंने अतिविज्ञानवाद का खंडन किया और कहा कि सच्चरित्र लोगों के हृदय से उत्पन्न होने वाला विचार ही प्रमाण होता है।

On 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2024, the Department of Philosophy conducted a lecture which was sponsored by the Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR). Speaking on the title 'Critical Thinking and Philosophising,' Prof. R. C. # University of Allahabad: As I Know This Great Institution \*Prof. M.H. Qureshi

It was in the month of July 1957 that I entered the campus of Allahabad University, with the result of the final examination of Intermediate in my hand. The confidence level was high as I could pass class XII in first division with a place in the merit list. I came from a small, non-descript town, Sultanpur (Avadh) where there was no electricity supply at that time and we had to study under the light of a lantern. I was filled with excitement and hope to get admission in B.A. (first year) based on my merit. For a young student from a small town, the first view of the Senate Hall and two grand buildings on the flanks (the library, at that time, on the left and the English Department on the right) was awe inspiring. The Banyan Tree at the back lawn of Senate Hall standing majestically with its large foliage attracted attention. Later we could know that this tree was the basis of the seal of the university which read, "QUOT RAMI TOT ARBORES" in Latin and "As many Branches so many Trees."

The campus, housing Arts and Commerce faculties, was witnessing a lot of buzz as new aspirants were running here and there to complete the admission process. I could get admission in B.A.Part-I, with English Literature, Economics and Geography. I could also get State Bursary ScholarshipofRs.60/per month based on my rank in the merit list of the Intermediate Examination.

Professor Shri Ranjan, a professor of Botany Department was the Vice Chancellor of the University when we joined in B.A.Part I in 1957.

Every Department of the university had academic giants. We were lucky to see some of the legendary figures such as Professors S. C. Deb, Prof.Raghupati Sahai Firaq Gorakhpuri, Ram Nath Dubey, Jamshed Kai khusro Mehta, Dharam Veer Bharti, Ram Kumar Verma, Ehtesham Husain and many more.

The English Department was being headed by Prof. S.C. Deb who was known as a "moving dictionary". I had a chance to go to his room in the month of November 1957 to request him to provide a teacher to our class as time was running out andthere was no teacher for our English Literature class. The class fellows asked me and Alopi Prasad Srivastava to meet and request Prof. Deb to arrange a teacher. We gathered courage, went to his room, knocked at the door and heard a roaring voice, 'come in' as we entered the room, he roared again, "what has brought you here? Meekly, I said, 'Sir, we do not have a teacher for our class, there must be some arrangement'. He said annoyingly 'you must get out!' Both of us realized our mistake and ran out of his room. We were surprised that the next morning, Mr. Lalit Mohan Upadhyay was there in the class room to teach us English literature. The class was happy that arrangement was made so quickly. We realized that Prof. Deb had a very soft heart within his tough exterior. We also used to attend the classes of Prof. K.K. Mehrotra, a very soft-spoken teacher taking classes sitting in his wheel chair. The other luminary was Prof RaghuPati Sahai Firaq Gorakhpuri, a professor of English and a renowned poet of Urdu. He conducted my viva in B.A. Final class. I still remember that the first question he asked was, "who was the founder of Banaras Hindu University?" My reply was, "Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya." The other question was, "why was he known as Malviya?" My reply was a mere guess that Malviya may be a subcaste of Brahmans. Firaq Saheb corrected me and said that he belonged to Malva that is why he was known as Malviya. He also reminded me that the question was asked because I was a student of Geography. Thus, I learnt a lesson of Geography of India from my Professor of English.

I had the opportunity to listen to him reciting his ghazals in the Mushairas held in Senate Hall as well as once in Mayo Hall lawns in Allahabad. I still remember two lines:



"Is khandahar mein hain, kuch chdiye toote huye Inheen se kaam chalao, bahut andhera hai".

The Geography and Education Departments shared the same building. Now, that building has been removed and the University library stands there. Geography department was headed by Prof. Ram Nath Dubey whom I had seen teaching P.G. classes sitting on an easy chair. The same year he retired. He never taught our class. After 44 years of leaving Allahabad, I was asked to deliver "R. N. Dubey Memorial Lecture in 2005 by my teacher Prof L. R. Singh. The lecture was presided over by Dubey ji's son- in- law, Shri T.N. Chaturvedi, Governor of Karnataka.

I have vivid memory of Prof. J. K. Mehta and Dr. P. D. Hajela who edited the book titled "Fundamentals of Economics" wherein the Gandhian concept of deliberate control of wants was propounded. Prof. Mehta lived in Civil Lines and always came to the Department in a rickshaw. He used to give free homeopathic medicines in the afternoon of Tuesdays. I also went to consult him for my acute cough and his medicine helped.

Allahabad University was established on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 1887 and its 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary was celebrated in 1958. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru was invited as the Chief Guest. A group of N.C.C. cadets were prepared to offer the Guard of Honour. I was one in the group and had a chance to see Nehru ji from close quarters as he walked along the file to inspect the guards.

I joined the M. A. course in Geography in 1959 and passed M.A. in first division and stood first in order of merit in 1961.
