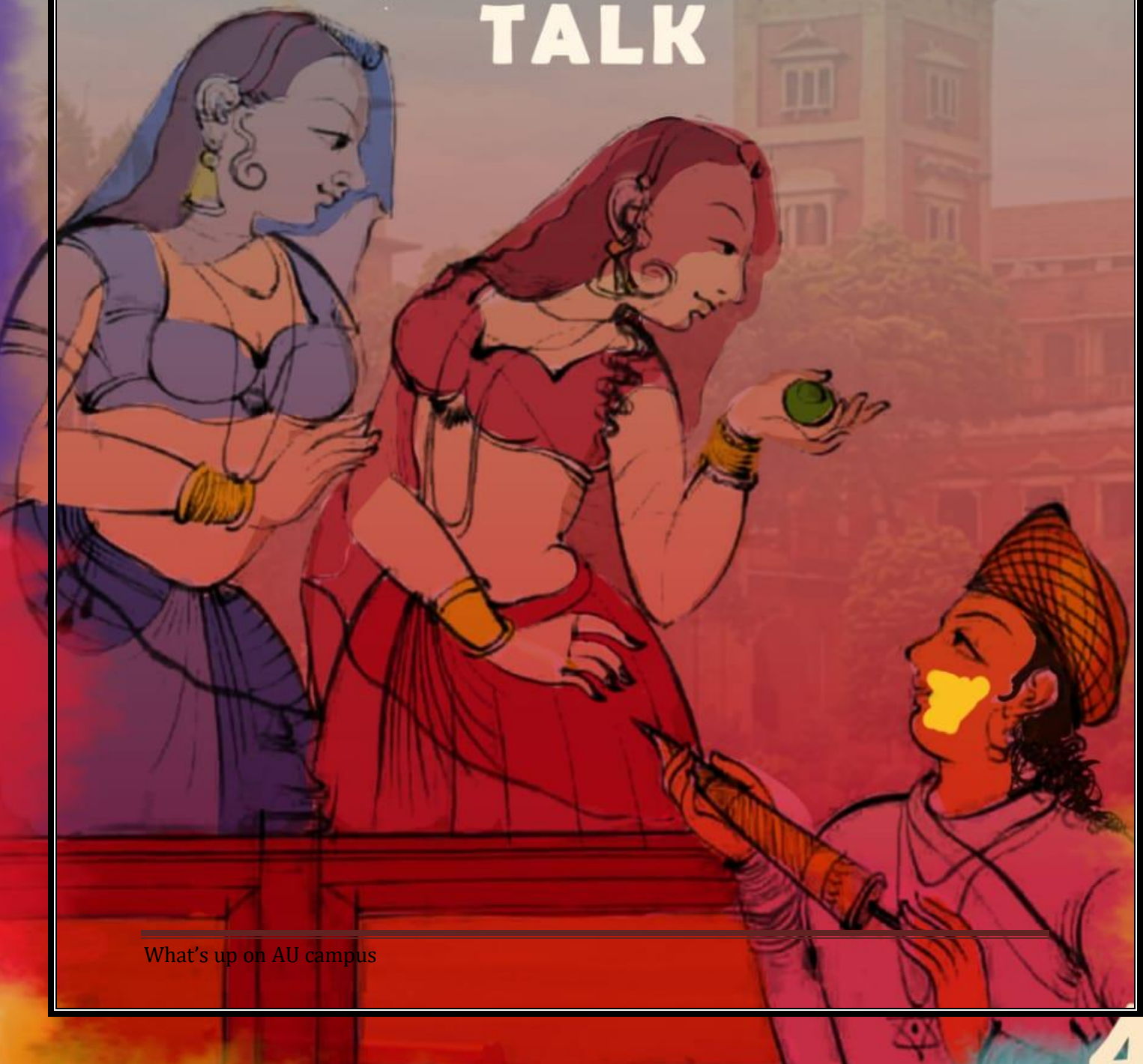

Incubation Centre

Under the kind patronage of our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof Sangita Srivastava, the Incubation Centre, University of Allahabad organised the Business Plan Competition 2026. The objective was to orient the students towards entrepreneurship. There was enthusiastic participation from more than 200 students from the various departments of the University. Finalist teams presented their innovative business ideas to an expert panel comprising Prof. (retd.) A.K. Singhal and Mr Rajiv Nayar, Founder, Modern Pipe Industries. Six teams won the prizes. The Chief Guest of the Prize Distribution Ceremony was Prof. N. K. Shukla, Dean, Student Welfare, University of Allahabad. Special guests were Dr. Sanjay Sharma, Senior President, Baidyanath Industries; and Mr. Tanmay Agrawal, Founder of Transcends and Living Green Farms. Prof Manish Srivastava, Dean R&D encouraged participants to nurture entrepreneurial skills. The welcome address was delivered by Dr. Shefali Nandan, coordinator, Incubation Centre. Dr. Sandeep Goyal, Event coordinator delivered the vote of thanks. Anchoring was done by Dr. Cherita, Event Co-cordinator and Dr. Rajesh Kumari. Department of Zoology

The Department of Zoology has successfully completed its first outreach program of 2025–2026 at Saidandur. The program emphasized the importance of anti-rabies and HPV vaccinations, conveyed through nukkad natak and poster presentations. A parallel initiative engaged farmers in interactive sessions on wheat harvesting and storage, Nilgai protection, drip irrigation, and included demonstrations of biological control measures.



Department of Botany

The Department of Botany successfully completed the first phase of its outreach activity on 27 March, 2026 at Kotari Pashim Village. Students presented a skit highlighting the importance of girls' education. This was followed by a demonstration and hands-on training session on mushroom cultivation, emphasizing its nutritional value and role in addressing various health issues. Additionally, composting techniques were demonstrated and harmful effects of chemical pesticides were discussed, aiming to discourage their use and encourage farmers to adopt organic fertilizers.



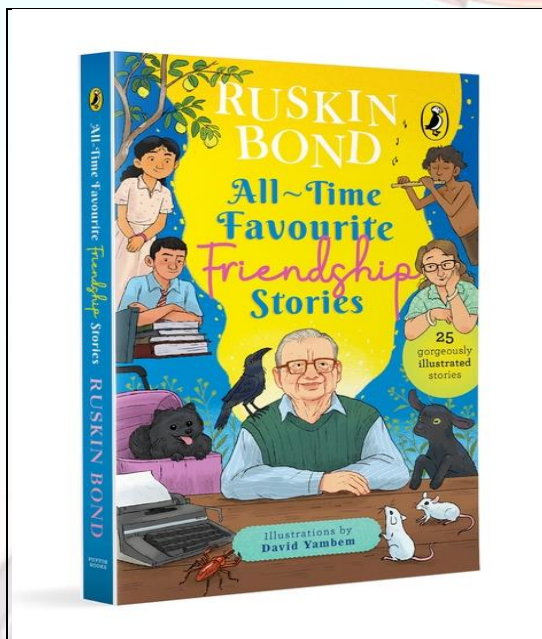
