**Dr. S. B. Ota** is a retired Joint Director General of the Archaeological Survey of India. He was awarded Tagore National Fellow of the Government of India to carry out his research on the Prehistory of Ladakh. Besides his services in ASI; the Government of India also assigned him the additional responsibility as the Director of Manav Sangrahalaya (IGRMS), Bhopal. He was the first Director of National Mission on Monuments and Antiquities launched by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India under the aegis of the Archaeological Survey of India. He has a unique educational background in both Anthropology and Archaeology. Dr. Ota is the recipient of the "Young Scientist Award" from the Indian Science Congress Association in 1987, awarded Charles Wallace Indian Trust Fellowship in 1995, and was a Short-term Visiting Fellow of the Japan Foundation in 2006. During his career in the Archaeological Survey of India, he has undertaken a large number of archaeological investigations in different areas of the country. Some of the main projects include salvage archaeological investigations of the submerged area of Narmada Valley Dam projects in Madhya Pradesh, prehistoric investigation in high altitude Ladakh Himalayas, geo-archaeological investigations of Acheulian sites in district Raisen, Madhya Pradesh etc.
